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
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ADVANCED TECHNOLOGY GUIDE

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KEYLESS ACCESS SYSTEM

Operate certain functions of your vehicle by simply having the remote within operating range.

Unlocking the Doors

Opening the Trunk



Press the trunk release button under the spoiler.



Engine Start/Stop Button

Accessory or On Mode

Use audio, power sockets, etc., without turning the engine on.



Press the ENGINE START/STOP button once (without pressing the brake pedal). Press it again for On mode.



Starting the Engine



Turning the Vehicle Off



Press and hold the brake pedal*, then press the ENGINE START/STOP button.



* For manual transmissions, press and hold the clutch.

Shift to Park*, then press the ENGINE START/STOP button.





Note: If you press the button and the shift lever is not in Park, the vehicle goes into Accessory mode.

* For manual transmissions, apply the emergency brake.

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INSTRUMENT PANEL INDICATORS

Briefly appear with each engine start. Red and amber indicators are most critical. Blue and green indicators are used for general information. See your Owner's Manual for more information.

MULTI-INFORMATION DISPLAY (MID)

Consists of several displays that provide you with useful information.

Accessing the MID




When you start the engine, the MID shows the last active display from the previous drive cycle.




To toggle between the MID main displays, press either Info button (\blacktriangle/∇).

To toggle between the lower displays, press SEL/RESET.

Customizing Settings Using the MID

Five groups of settings can be programmed using the MID*: Meter Setup, Position Setup, Keyless Access Setup, Lighting Setup, and Door Setup.

Programming the Auto Door Unlock Setting



Press either Info button to toggle to the "Customize Settings" display, then press SEL/RESET to enter the menu.



1. Select CHANGE SETTINGS.



2. Select DOOR SETUP.



3. Select AUTO DOOR UNLOCK.

4. Select ALL DOORS With SHIFT TO P.



5. Once the setting has been saved, **select** EXIT.



Tire Pressure Monitoring System

Alerts you when one or more of your tires has significantly low pressure. Toggle to the tire pressure monitor display to view pressure readings on the MID.

How It Works



- If the tire pressure drops significantly below recommended levels: • The low tire pressure indicator comes on.
- A "CHECK TIRE PRESSURE" message appears on the MID, showing
- which tire(s) have low pressure.



What to Do

- 1. Visually inspect the tires for damage.
- 2. Use a tire air pressure gauge (or check the MID) to check which tire(s) have low pressure.



3. Inflate the tire(s), if necessary, to the recommended pressures listed on the label on the driver's doorjamb.





DRIVING POSITION MEMORY SYSTEM (DPMS)

Store driver's seat and side mirror positions into memory for each corresponding keyless remote (1 or 2), which are recalled when you unlock the driver's door with the remote and enter the vehicle.

Programming the DPMS

1. Turn the vehicle on. Shift into Park (P), or set the parking brake for manual transmission vehicles.

Note: Stored positions can also be recalled by pressing one of the memory buttons (1 or 2) on the door.

REARVIEW CAMERA

For added convenience, the area behind your vehicle is displayed to help you navigate while backing up.

How It Works

- When you shift into Reverse, a real-time image of the area behind your vehicle is shown in the navigation display.
- Yellow parking guidelines appear to help you judge distance.
- Adjust the screen brightness by turning the Interface Dial.
- The display turns off when you shift out of Reverse.



REVERSE TILT DOOR MIRRORS

When you shift into Reverse (R), you can tilt either outside door mirror down slightly to improve your view as you parallel park. Shifting out of Reverse returns the tilted mirror to its original position.

How It Works



- To tilt the driver's door mirror, move the mirror selector switch to the left (L) position.
- To tilt the passenger's side door mirror, move the mirror selector switch to the right (R) position.
- To turn the feature off, move the switch to the middle position.




BLIND SPOT INFORMATION (BSI) SYSTEM (Advance Package)

Assists you in determining if there are vehicles in your blind spots.

How It Works

A radar sensor on each corner of the rear bumper alerts you to a detected vehicle in your blind spot.



Minimum operating speed: 6-7 mph

When a vehicle is detected in your blind spot, the blind spot indicator turns on and stays lit until the area is clear.



When your turn signal is on and a vehicle is detected, the blind spot indicator blinks until the area is clear or the turn signal is turned off.



VOICE RECOGNITION

To keep your eyes on the road and hands on the wheel, use voice commands for hands-free calling, navigation, audio, climate control, and AcuraLink functions. For a full list of commands, say "*Display information*" and "Voice Info."

Key Functions Operational by Voice Command

Control five different systems with the steering wheel buttons and the ceiling microphone.





Pick-Up button: Answer an incoming call, or go directly to the Cellular Phone screen.

Hang-Up button: End a call or decline a - call.

Talk button: Give HFL, navigation, audio, - climate control, or AcuraLink commands.

Back button: Cancel a command and - return to the previous screen.

Voice Command Tips

- To hear a list of available commands at any time, press and release the Talk button, then say "Help."
- When using the Talk button, wait for a beep, then say a command.
- When the Talk button is pressed, all available voice commands are highlighted in blue.
- Speak in a clear, natural voice without pausing between words.
- Reduce all background noise.
- Adjust the dashboard and side vents away from the microphone in the ceiling.
- Close the windows.



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NAVIGATION

Real-time navigation system uses GPS and a map database to show your current location and help guide you to a desired destination.

Entering a Destination Using Voice Commands

Set a destination using a street address. For other destination options, see your Navigation Manual.

Press and release the Talk button before you say a command.



Using the "Find Nearest" Command

Find a nearby point of interest, such as a gas station, movie theater, restaurant, etc.

Press and release the Talk button before you say a command.

1. From the map screen, say "Find nearest ATM."



2. A list of the nearest ATMs in your area is displayed by shortest distance to destination.




3. Say the number next to the destination you want to select.

ACURALINK REAL-TIME TRAFFIC^{TM*} (if equipped)

Provides continuously updated info, including traffic speed, incidents, and construction in major metro areas.

Press and release the Talk button before you say a command.

Traffic Rerouting™

How to Use HFL

Pick-Up button: Answer an incoming call, or go directly to the Cellular Phone screen.

Hang-Up button: End a call or - decline an incoming call.

Talk button: Give HFL commands.-

Back button: Cancel a command and return to the previous screen.

Pairing Your Phone

Use this pairing method when no phone has ever been paired to the system. You can pair your compatible phone only when the vehicle is stopped.



Playing *Bluetooth* Audio

- Make sure your phone is on and paired to Bluetooth® HandsFreeLink® (see page 22).
- 2. Press HDD/AUX until Bluetooth Audio appears.



 Press "play" on your phone; sound is redirected to the audio system. Make sure the volume on your phone is properly adjusted.

- The play/pause function and remote audio controls may not be supported on all phones.

HARD DISC DRIVE (HDD) AUDIO

Automatically record CDs onto your vehicle's hard drive (by system default). Songs begin to record once a CD is inserted into the disc slot.

Playing HDD Audio

1. Press HDD/AUX until HDD appears.



 The first song of the last recorded album or the last song selected plays. Press (IM)(IM) or (+)(-) to change tracks.







Searching for Music

1. Press AUDIO.



2. Push the selector up to select MUSIC SEARCH.



3. Select one of the categories.



4. Select a track and press ENTER to begin play.



iPod®*or USB FLASH DRIVE

Play audio files from your compatible iPod or USB flash drive through your vehicle's audio system. See your Owner's Manual for a list of compatible devices.

Connecting and Playing Audio

1. Open the center console, and pull out the USB adapter cable.











2. Press HDD/AUX until iPod or USB appears.



SAFETY REMINDER

Your vehicle is equipped with airbags. Airbags do not replace seat belts; they add to the protection offered by seat belts. Airbags can help protect you in some types of collisions, but they do not provide protection in all collisions.

This fuel is guaranteed to contain the proper level of detergent additives and be free of metallic additives. This helps avoid build-up of deposits in your engine and emission control system. Because the level of detergency and harmful metallic additives (such as MMT) in gasoline vary in the market, Acura endorses the use of "TOP TIER Detergent Gasoline" where available to help maintain the performance and reliability of your vehicle.
